1. The sixty-fourth session of the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) was held at the World Conference Center Bonn in Bonn, Germany, from 8 to 18 June 2026.
2. The Chair of the SBI, Julia Gardiner (Australia), opened the session and welcomed all Parties and observers. She also welcomed Eyad Aljubran (Saudi Arabia) as Vice-Chair and Kamil Salazar (Belize) as Rapporteur.
3. The opening included remarks by the UNFCCC Executive Secretary, Simon Stiell, and the President-Designate, Murat Kurum, and President of Negotiations, Chris Bowen, of the thirty-first session of the Conference of the Parties.
