Draft conclusions proposed by the Chairs

1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) and the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) considered matters relating to the Sharm el-Sheikh mitigation ambition and implementation work programme.
2. The SBSTA and the SBI agreed to continue consideration of this matter at SB 65 (November 2026) with a view to recommending a draft decision thereon for consideration and adoption by the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement at its eighth session (November 2026).
3. The SBSTA and the SBI requested the secretariat to organize, under the guidance of the Chairs of the subsidiary bodies, a pre-sessional workshop, open to all Parties, on the continuation, functioning and effectiveness of the work programme, to be held back-to-back with SB 65.
4. The SBSTA and the SBI took note of the estimated budgetary implications of the activity to be undertaken by the secretariat referred to in paragraph 3 above.
5. They requested that the actions of the secretariat called for in these conclusions be undertaken subject to the availability of financial resources.
